# Introduction to CARZON GPS TRACKING

Our system is very useful to individuals and businesses, with your CARZON TRACKING you will be able to track your vehicle/s live with our easy to use system. You will be able to playback your history and check your vehicle/s from anywhere and at any time. With our easy system you will also be able to check the milage, speed and geo fence of your vehicle/s.

## Getting Started

Once you're tracking is installed, you will receive a seven digit code that you will use to track your vehicle/s. You can download our app for iPhone and Android from the carzon tracking website ([www.carzongps.com](http://www.carzongps.com)), or track your vehicle from the site. Once this is done you will be able to enter your code and login and see your vehicle/s.


# Logging In *Website and App*

Enter your seven digit code into the Account and Password section. The Account and Password should be the same. Here you will also be able to change the language. Now you can log in and see your vehicle/s.



# Once Your Logged In



## *Opening screen / Home page*

Once you are logged in you will get this screen.




## Monitor Page

On the left hand side column you will be able to see your vehicle/s, and when you click on one of them the map will move to show the position of the vehicle.




## Options


Once you click on your vehicle three subheadings will appear below the vehicle name (Tracking, Playback and More).



When this is clicked it will take you to a full screen of your vehicle/s.



When this is clicked you will go to the playback mode. Here you can enter the start and stop date of which you want to check your vehicle and see the history, including the speed and milage.




Enter start date and time as well as the stop date and time and click play.

**Check Command:** This will show the commands that have been sent to the vehicle, the response time and messages.

**Alarm Overview:** Displays the vehicle name, any low battery alarms, any cut off alarms, any vibration alarms and SOS alarms.

**Device Statistics:** This will show you the mileage report, overspeed details and stop details. Each of these details can be downloaded as an Excel file.


**Alarm Details:** This will show the alarm statistics, alarm details and geo-fence, which can also be downloaded as an Excel file.
